LOCATION SITE/ACCESS:

If you are towing a trailer or caravan it is best to use the road opposite the A687 to enter the village and go onto the Waterfalls Walk car park, authentic camping is in the field opposite the cafe alongside the riverbank with caravans and motorhomes on the hard standing, at top of the car park through the archway, modern tents on the grass in the same car park by the river bank.

Cavalry horses will be accommodated in a nearby field.

ARRIVAL/ DEPART BY TIME: Anytime Friday until Lunchtime Monday.
