

What: Heritage Event

Where: Old Christ Church, Waterloo Road, Waterloo, Liverpool L22 1RE

Greetings !

This e-mail invites you to a one day event on Saturday 10th Sept starting at 10am and finishing no later than 5pm.

Its a living history and display day, in support of Bob Jones' organisation, i.e. the chaps who research Civil War graves in Merseyside for re-dedication and research connections between Merseyside and the ACW.

At Old Christ Church, Waterloo Road (at its junction with Alexandra Rd), Waterloo, Liverpool L22 1RE. This is a listed building, now used for community purposes and is to be the location for this celebration of 150 years from the ACW. Parking is readily available on the car park or on the abutting roads. The Church is surrounded by a grass area where we can camp for the day and do living history, drill displays, recruit, cook our food (bring your own raised fires and wood) and entertain the public as only we know how !! Got a musical instrument and can play it e.g. drum, violin, flute, banjo = those that a Civil War soldier would have had (NOT a Grand Piano !!) then please bring it along and play. Got a flag of the period and a stand to put it in ? Then bring that, too. Got some of your Regimental recruiting leaflets ? Bring them, too !

Waterloo is about 5 miles north of Liverpool on the way to Southport / Formby / Crosby, after the Seaforth Docks.

During the day, Bob Jones' organisation and friends will be giving lectures, poetry recitals and ACW displays inside the Church. Its a promotional / recruiting event, so NO Registration Fee, and NO firing / gunpowder, but come in uniform + kit and bring your personal weapon anyway.

For safety reasons, if anybody brings a fire then it must be roped-and-pinned off from the public, for H&S reasons. Many visitors are expected. Whilst both sides of ACWS will be putting up a few tents - a small street each - but quite close to each other, inside will be exhibitions etc a bit like the Birkenhead Town Hall event earlier this year, put on by others.
